**THE NEW YEAR IS APPROACHING QUICKLY. HOW DO WE  
PREPARE?**

As the new year approaches, even before we have eaten our Thanksgiving turkey or put up our Christmas decorations, we need to start planning for the new year in our Church. Stewardship, and new officer elections, are at the top of the planning list.

**Stewardship:** Treasurer and stewardship chairman Milla Fincham has the following message for all HSCPC members and friends.

As the seasons turn, so do our thoughts toward our future and the new year. The Finance Committee is starting to look toward next year and the 2017 budget. In order to plan a realistic budget it is necessary to get a good estimate of how much income there will be to work with. For this purpose church members and friends are asked to make a pledge in support of the financial operation of the Church. This pledge is basically the offering you plan to make each week, times 52 weeks.

In the next few weeks you will be receiving your pledge cards for making your pledge for next year. Your pledge is very important as we look toward general expenses, property maintenance and improvements, and special missions of our Church. Please give prayerful thought to how much you can offer financially to your Church. As circumstances change, the amount can be altered at any time during the year, but an initial pledge is really important from all participants in our special little Church.



**Election of Elders and Deacons:** The nominating committee is now convening to begin the process of selecting nominees for the very important roles of Elders and Deacons.

*Elders* form the governing body of the Church, called the Session. Their function is to oversee and direct the business and the ministry of the Church.

*Deacons* form the Deacon Board for oversight of pastoral care. Their duties are very diverse, but all fall into the category of caring for and providing for the welfare of the congregation.

If you know of someone that you believe possesses the gifts of faith and leadership (including yourself) and might be called to be an Elder or Deacon in the coming year, please make it a point to convey this to *Jan Norrish*, chairman of the Nominating Committee. All input will be more than welcome, and all suggestions will be prayerfully considered.
