
First Reading

Matthew 14: 13 - 21

Sermon: *"More Than Enough and Leftovers"*



This Sunday, the New Testament reading is from Matthew, Chapter 14, verses 13-21. Here, Matthew tells of the miracle of the Loaves and Fishes.

"A great crowd had gathered to hear Jesus. As evening approached, the disciples told Jesus to send the crowds back to their homes to prepare their dinners.

Jesus said to them *"They need not go away; you give them something to eat"*. They replied, *"We have nothing here but five loaves and two fish."* And he said, *"Bring them here to me."* Then he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fishes, he looked up to heaven, and blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And all ate and were filled; and they took up what was left over of the broken pieces, twelve baskets full."

COMMUNION: We celebrate the Lord's Supper on the first Sunday of every month. We also designate these Sundays as "Mission Sundays". Donations help provide funds and services for those in need within our own Church, within the immediate Community such as Banner Lake school programs, and through charitable organizations such as House of Hope. If you wish to make a donation to the Missions program on this August 6th Mission Sunday, use the blue and white envelope found in your envelope offering box, or a Mission Envelope located in the back of the pews.

MINUTE FOR MISSIONS: In this week's Worship Service, time has been set aside for a special Missions presentation. **Simone Scott, Director of the Banner Lake After School Program (BLAST)** will talk with us about the Banner Lake Backpack Giveaway Program organized by the Banner Lake Club and to which HSCPC is donating backpacks and school supplies.

BANNER LAKE BACK TO SCHOOL MISSION PROJECT

HSCPC received 50 backpacks from the Presbytery of Tropical Florida, and our members and friends have been very generously providing the supplies to fill them.



The conference room in the church office building is filling up with a wonderful variety of school supplies, and many people have made monetary contributions so the Banner Lake Club can purchase additional supplies as needed.

There is still time to make a donation before the supplies and money are delivered to Banner Lake for their big Backpack giveaway party. You can purchase any of the supplies listed below and bring them to the Church this coming Sunday.

Or you can make a financial donation at the Sunday Worship Service by putting cash or a check in a Mission envelope, marking it as "Banner Lake school supplies", and putting it in the offering plate. Checks should be made out to HSCPC.

The Most Needed School Supplies are:

#2 Pencils, Erasers, 3-Hole Lined Notebook Paper, Crayons, Water-Based Markers, Any school supplies will be most welcome, but if you have not yet purchased supplies to donate, and intend to do so, please limit your donations to the above items.

The backpacks need to be filled with school supplies appropriate to the age of the children receiving them. Therefore, our job is to organize the supplies by category and deliver them to Banner Lake, along with the backpacks, so that their volunteers can fill them accordingly.

If you can provide a helping hand, come to the conference room in the office building after the coffee hour (about 12:15pm). The boxed supplies will then be delivered to Banner Lake early in the week.

Many hands make short work. The more volunteers we have the quicker the job can get done. This is a wonderful time to work with your church friends on this most worthwhile project.
