Dear Friends in Christ,

This week I went with Milla Finchum to deliver a check from the church to the Banner Lake Community Center. It was the desire of your session that the extra monies received from the Christmas Angel Tree go to help children—the reason behind the Angel Tree. The children's work at Banner Lake was their choice.

It was my first visit to Banner Lake, a historic community west of US1, established in the 1930's by residents on "the island" to provide housing for their domestic workers and caretakers. Later, these same good-hearted folk built a community center for the residents. Today that community center is busting at the seams daily with children, adults, tutoring, and activities. I was very impressed!

I met their Director, and Simone Scott, the after-school Program Director. I saw

buses arrive and 60 or more children running with excitement into the building for refreshments, games, guitar lessons, and tutoring. Yes, tutoring. Ms. Scott explained that so many of these children's parents work late, and so when they go home it is late, time only for dinner and bed. "If they don't do their homework here, it doesn't get done", she said. Every week staff and volunteers assist and tutor children in math, reading, and everything. Impressive work.

Every weekday at 11:30am there is a simple nutritious meal served for adults, mostly seniors. They come from Banner Lake, and the nearby mobile home communities. Every day, food for seniors—those who often fail to cook for themselves. Again, I was impressed.

I know that many of you have supported this good work for a long time. I was especially proud that HSCPC has been a long-time supporter of Banner Lake. Some have perhaps given to the new addition underway at the Community Center. But I'm wondering... if God might be leading us to do more? HSCPC has a heart for the community. It is in the heart of the Hobe Sound. Would you reflect and pray with me as to how we as a church might be more connected to this good and respected work?

I welcome your thoughts.
