

Using songs, stories, and humor to communicate his faith, Brent has crisscrossed the United States countless times as well as performing in Ireland, Australia, Canada, and the Caribbean.

Brent is also the author and illustrator of the Audrey Amaka storybook series and, most recently, "The Gingerbread"—an original take on the classic Gingerbread Man story. He is currently working on his fifth children's book.

In addition to an instrumental album, a children's album, and a Christmas LP, Brent has released three studio albums. According to Brent, his newest release, Hope & Hunger, is his most personal. With songs of hope and redemption, Brent encourages his listeners to passionately seek God's Kingdom while resting in God's faithfulness.

Brent's career in the creative arts is full time. With few exceptions, he performs 120-130 times each year. Whether it's in a church, school, or at a special event, Brent welcomes every opportunity to share.

HSCPC ANNUAL MEETING

The **Annual Meeting** of the Hobe Sound Community Presbyterian Church will be held on **Sunday, February 11, 2018** immediately following the Worship Service. At this meeting the activities of the past year will be reviewed, the budget for 2018 will be approved, and new Ruling Elders and Deacons will be elected, as well as the 2018 nominating committee. Anyone is welcome to attend the meeting, but only active members are eligible to vote.

OFFERING ENVELOPES

The boxes of offering envelopes for 2018 are available on the Church Sanctuary porch. If you do not find one with your name on it, call or email Diane in the office and she will provide one for you.

The first envelope you will find in the box is the **PER CAPITA APPORTIONMENT**. Each year the Church must contribute to the Presbytery a given amount for each active member on its rolls. This amount varies with the needs of the Presbytery, synod, and General Assembly. Our church, with an official active membership as of January 1, 2017 of 87, must pay **\$2,909.55**

The **PER CAPITA** amount for HSCPC members this year (that amount to be paid by each active member) is **\$34.23**. This payment is each active member's portion of the Church's \$2,909.55 financial commitment to the Presbytery. Any **PER CAPITA** payment not made by the active member must be taken out of the Church treasury.

If you are an active member of HSCPC but are not currently attending worship services, you still are responsible for making this payment. Make your check payable to HSCPC, identify it as for "Per Capita", and bring it or mail it to the

Church.
