BANNER LAKE BACK TO SCHOOL MISSION PROJECT

Each year, as the new school year approaches, Hobe Sound Community Presbyterian Church participates in the **BACKPACK Giveaway** organized by the **Banner Lake Club**. Through this program, children in the Banner Lake community in Hobe Sound are provided with the school supplies they will need for the coming year.

The Presbytery of Tropical Florida generously provides

backpacks to any Church in its district that participates in a school supply donation program. HSCPC has this year requested and received 50 backpacks, *and it is now the responsibility of its generous members and friends to provide the supplies to fill them.* This can be done in two ways:



1. You can purchase any of the supplies listed below and bring them to the Church prior to **August 9**. A container will be available on the Church porch each Sunday for this purpose.

2. You can make a financial donation which will be given to the Banner Lake Club for use in purchasing additional supplies. For this, you can use a Mission envelope and mark it as “Banner Lake school supplies”. It can be put in the offering plate or taken / mailed to the Church office by August 9. Checks should be made out to HSCPC.

The Most Needed School Supplies are:

#2 Pencils, Erasers, 3-Hole Lined Notebook Paper, Crayons, Water-Based Markers, Any school supplies will be most welcome, but if you have not yet purchased supplies to donate, and intend to do so, please limit your donations to the above items.
