For the past couple of years our church, through the wonderful ministry of the Session, Deacons and the Missions Committee, has been helping out a homeless and disabled church member. This past January, at the suggestion of Pastor Ben, the unused Sunday School room was offered to him as a temporary place to stay until more permanent arrangements could be made. While here he has volunteered his help, particularly with Building and Grounds Committee projects.

Unfortunately, we have been advised by our property insurance company that we are jeopardizing any potential coverage by housing someone on our non-residential property. As a result, Session regretfully had to ask him to leave. As a transition, provisions were made by the Church to pay for a week's stay at a local hotel, after which he will have to find alternative living arrangements. He expressed his thanks for the church's generosity of allowing him to stay so long at the church and for the church paying for the hotel.

We will continue to try to help in all ways possible while this young man continues to work toward improving his situation. Please keep him in your prayers.
