#### **TRINITY SUNDAY**

You know the expression, "Words cannot describe..." "Perhaps you have used it yourself or someone has said it to you in one form or another. What else do we have other than words to express our feelings or our thoughts?"

And how can words ever express the nature and character of God? The early Christian believers struggled with this. The Hebrew religion was strictly monotheistic. Jews believed that there was only one true God in the midst of their polytheistic world.

The initial followers of Jesus came to realize that His message was unique. Jesus referred to God as Father in heaven, and promised that after his leaving the Holy Spirit would come. Are all three divine and equal in their divinity? How could Jesus be both human and divine? How could Jesus be in heaven and his Spirit be on earth?

Back to “words cannot describe... “ what is a divine mystery? Yet the early believers sought to do their best. In the year 325 the “church fathers” gathered in Nicaea in an attempt to put into words what the original Christian generation experienced. The result was the Nicene Creed. It uses two Greek words “ousia” which means essence, and “hypostasis” which means “distinct” to state that God is one essence but three distinct persons. Despite the Creed, the nature of God is still a mystery to be acknowledged by faith.

This Sunday, the first Sunday after Pentecost, is designated as **Trinity Sunday** on our Christian Liturgical Calendar. The message is entitled “What Kind of Theologian Are You? Join us and you might just find you are a better theologian than you thought!

On other trips they have gone to a prison into which no other group has ever been allowed before. They don't tell the prisoners until just before the performance because of the immense excitement."*

Therefore, they are doing various concerts throughout our area to help with expenses. A good will offering will be collected following each concert, and the collection will be shared among the musicians.
