We have entered into the Lenten season, with eyes set on the coming of Easter/Resurrection Sunday on April 16th. So let me share a few times and dates for your family's planning.

• **April 9th Holy Week Beginning Sunrise Service.** This traditional, informal service begins with the rising of the sun on Palm Sunday (about 7am) at the home of Judy Doverspike, 141 N Beach Road, Hobe Sound, FL 33455. A short celebratory service is followed by breakfast. Please call Judy at 772-546-7308 for

• **April 9th Palm Sunday.** We will usher in Holy Week with palms, singing and worship.

• **April 13th Maundy Thursday.** At 6:00PM is the HSCPC Soup Supper. Homemade “soup for you!” Our Maundy Thursday service begins at 7:00PM and includes the Lord’s Supper. We remember the last mandate of Jesus: “Love one another as I have loved you”. This mandate (from the Latin) became our Maundy/Mandate service.

• **April 16th Easter Sunday *Two Services are offered: 8:30 AM & 10:30 AM.*** Between the services there will be coffee and refreshments and an activity TBA for the children. We encourage members to consider attending the 8:30 AM service in order to make room for our expected guests on Easter Sunday.

I hope you’ll make every effort to be in attendance at these faith-shaping services.
