## A NEW AIR CONDITIONER HAS BEEN INSTALLED IN THE FELLOWSHIP HALL KITCHEN

As you can see from the above message from the Deacons, their wish for a cooler fellowship hall kitchen has been fulfilled.

It is with special gratitude that we thank **Len and Milla Finchum** for taking on this project, researching the possibilities, recommending and arranging for purchase of the appropriate AC unit, and installing it in the kitchen. Being a free-standing unit it needed to be vented, and Len figured out how to vent it through the stove vent system, not an easy job by any means.

The unit can be turned on and off with a power switch, so it will only be turned on when the kitchen is in use. thus conserving on energy use.



The system was first put to use last Sunday, and has received good reviews from the Deacons who served as hosts at coffee hour following the Sunday service.
