It's a festive party designed to celebrate each of the nominees for their unique contributions to the classroom, their students, and our community. During this special evening, school spirit is in full swing as everyone cheers, dances, and even struts to the beat of specially selected music as each nominee makes his or her way to the stage in anticipation of the winning name being revealed.

The district winner then represents the Martin County School District in the competition to become the Florida Department of Education's Teacher of the Year."

A HOLIDAY MISSION PROJECT

Once again this year we have the opportunity to participate in the **OPERATION CARE FOR HEROES** program. For the next few weeks, mission committee members will be collecting items for this program.

Operation Care for Heroes is a 501© 3 nonprofit organization collecting donations and raising funds for postage to send care packages to our soldiers in Afghanistan and other war zones. Each box shipped to an APO in Afghanistan costs \$17.40 and the group has shipped over 2,500 boxes since 2008.
